The youth that are looking on Like Ulises who is in the green shirt taking a picture could only reflect on the years he has growing up from the age of 15 to now at the age of 27. Only seeing growth, change, and redemption. God has shown His fruit through all those who have committed their lives to Jesus and this fruit is now pouring into others. Only God can do such a miracle.



We pray over each person before they are Baptized. I always ask them one more question, “who do you love the most?” Jesus, they exclaim!!! Amen. Remember these young adults are in conditions that are hard with less than the most who are the same age in the States. With a 65% unemployment rate and failing education system it is hard to want change when living the “worldly way” is so much easier and more temporarily fulfilling. However, the youth we serve are making a decision to Love God with all their hearts and not worrying about what their friends, family or schoolmates say. This is important.
